ARMS Kiwi-English Pronunciation Course

Producing Intelligible English in a Kiwi-English Environment

This course builds an awareness of individual **pronunciation** habits. It provides tools for effecting pronunciation changes that will result in more intelligible speech and effective communication. The course is taught by a highly experienced trained English Language expert, in a relaxed group, with an individualised focus. A course pack is provided that includes audio-based exercises for daily practice.
